V. ADMISSION, FEES, SCHOLARSHIPS, AND AWARD

ADMISSION

Citizens of the Republic of Kazakhstan

Step 1. Take the Comprehensive Testing

- Register for the program on the university website (<u>https://lp.mnu.kz/ru/magistratura</u>).
- Register for the comprehensive testing on the website <u>https://app.testcenter.kz/auth/registration</u> from June 1 to July 8, 2024.
- Comprehensive testing takes place from July 20 to August 10, 2024.

Step 2. Achieve the Passing Score

• For admission to the specialized (one-year) master's program, a minimum of 30 out of 70 points is required (at least 7 points in all sections).

Step 3. Submit the Document Package to the Admission Committee

- Original bachelor's degree diploma with an appendix in law or a related field. Those without a legal education will need to study additional legal disciplines.
- Proof of English language proficiency with an IELTS score of 6.0 or its equivalent (TOEFL).
- Six 3x4 photographs (original and online version).
- Medical certificate form 075-U and fluorography image.
- Passport or identity card.
- Certificate of Comprehensive Testing (CT) results.
- Receipt of payment for the admission fee.

Foreign Citizens

Step 1. Register for the Program and Submit Documents

- Register for the program on the WIPO website (<u>https://welc.wipo.int/acc/index.jsf?page=aipCatalog.xhtml&lang=en&cc=LLM_KAZ_AKHSTAN#plus_LLM_KAZAKHSTAN</u>) from May 16 to July 5, 2024. - Bachelor's degree diploma with an appendix in law or a related field. Those without a legal education will need to study additional legal disciplines.
- Proof of English language proficiency with an IELTS score of 6.0 or its equivalent (TOEFL, Duolingo). Candidates from countries where English is an official language are exempt from the language requirement.
- One 3x4 photograph.
- Passport.
- Letter of recommendation.
- Resume.
- Motivation letter (minimum of 500 words).

Step 2. Pass the Interview

• Interview from July 10 to July 20, 2024.

Step 3. Submit All Required Original Documents

- Educational documents, passport, photograph, medical certificate, and other documents.
- Document submission period: August 20-25, 2024.

FEES

The tuition fee for the 2024-2025 academic year is 1,875,000 KZT (approx.. \$4167). The fee is calculated based on the total number of credits (37,500 KZT per credit). Students must earn 60 credits over two semesters. The tuition fee does not include 10 credits for WIPO Academy courses, which are taught by WIPO Academy instructors free of charge.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Ministry of Higher Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan has allocated 10 state educational grants for citizens of Kazakhstan. WIPO will provide up to five grants/scholarships. Applicants requesting WIPO sponsorship should register online through the https://welc.wipo.int/acc/index.jsf?page=aipCatalog.xhtml&lang=en&cc=LLM_KAZAKHSTAN, via "WIPO Scholarship registration" and upload all required documents.
